Inter Collegiate Cultural Competition

Guidelines for the Cultural event

Theme- "Our culture Our Pride - Bridging to empower future."

Each team can include the following program based on the theme

- 1. Dance- Solo, Group (classical/western/eastern/folk) are allowed
- 2. Song- Solo, Group (classical/western/eastern/ folk are allowed) music can be played by individual or back ground music.
- 3. Skit
- 4. M C (Master of Ceremony) (must)
- 5. Fashion Show
- 6. Mime

Note:-

- 1. Each institute is permitted to send only one team, and each team will have a total of 15 minutes, including stage setup and clearance.
- 2. Registration for the conference is mandatory to participate in the cultural program.
- 3. The Google form must be submitted by the specified deadline. Incomplete, incorrect, or fraudulent forms may be rejected by the cultural committee.
- 4. Representatives from each college must be present at the designated time on the day of the conference for slot allocation via the lottery system.
- 5. The respective teams are responsible for arranging their own props required for the performance.
- 6. The team must be ready 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time.
- 7. The judging will be based on factors such as rhythm, formation, expression, costume, makeup, synchronization and coordination, clarity of voice, sound quality, lyrics, choreography, props, timing, creativity, stage utilization, M.C. presence, clear theme, and the overall performance.
- 8. Any theme that does not align with the conference theme will lead to disqualification.
- 9. The decision of the judges shall be final.

- 5. No additional time will be allotted for stage setup and clearance.
- 6. Costumes should not be vulgar, obscene, or abusive. They must be respectful of all religions, cultures, traditions, and ethnicities.
- 7. Participants must strictly follow the event's rules and regulations, maintain proper discipline, and exhibit appropriate behavior, language, and respect towards one another.
- 8. Music files must be submitted in two copies on a USB flash drive at least 30 minutes before the scheduled event time.
- 9. Instructions for the preliminary rounds will be provided soon.
